





Erbslöh Clarvinyl

Treatment of bitter compounds and off flavours

Product description

Erbslöh Clarvinyl is a powdered product based on PVPP and casein, combined with aluminium silicates and cellulose. It is used to treat bitter compounds and off flavours. The effect is based on the synergy between the ingredients that intensifies the effect of the individual products.

Intended purpose	 Removal of green and bitter notes during intense extraction, or removal of unripe tannins in red wines Preventative and curative treatment for oxidation faults Selective removal of various undesirable flavour and aroma faults Perfect for white and rosé wines vinified from damaged or diseased grapes
Benefits	 Erbslöh Clarvinyl is gentle on the wine and is precipitated as a solid deposit It can be used in both must and wine
Guidance	Small-scale prior testing is recommended

Permitted according to EU Commission Regulation no. (EG) 934/2019. User must check compliance with national regulations. Laboratory tested for purity and quality.

Dosage

Dissolve in 10 times the volume of water and leave to prime for 1 - 2 hours. Mix well when adding to the vessel.

Intended purpose	Dosage
White and rosé wines	Preventative: 20 - 40 g/100 L
	Damaged grapes: 60 - 70 g/100 L, sometimes up to 100 g/100 L
Red wines	10 - 20 g/100 L
Statutory maximum dosage	400 g/100 L

Storage

Erbslöh Clarvinyl must always be stored in a cool, dry place, away from odours. Packs which have been opened should be immediately hermetically sealed.
